

ROUND 1 (WINTER 2017) GRANT RECIPIENTS

SCHOOL MATERIALS REIMBURSEMENT

The Port Arthur Education Foundation Rebuild Adams Elementary: \$122,800

Replace materials and resources lost during Hurricane Harvey for Adams Elementary school students; provide phonics, spelling and math kits, and workbooks for more than 600 students and 70 teachers.

Port Arthur Education Foundation Support for Lamar State College Port Arthur: \$148,470

Replace textbooks lost and destroyed during Hurricane Harvey for 245 students at Lamar State College Port Arthur.

Port Arthur Education Foundation Rebuild Sabine Pass ISD: \$66,984

Replace educational and recreational equipment, uniforms, books computers and furniture lost during Hurricane Harvey for 260 students in the Sabine Pass ISD.

FIRST RESPONDER/PUBLIC EMPLOYEE DISASTER ASSISTANCE

100 Club of Southeast Texas

The 100 Club of Southeast Texas First Responders' Hurricane Harvey Flood Assistance Grant Project: \$500,000

Support 500 emergency and first responders in Jefferson, Hardin and Orange Counties who experienced property loss due to Hurricane Harvey.

DISASTER MITIGATION INFRASTRUCTURE

The Salvation Army of Port Arthur Flood Remediation of The Salvation Army Buildings in Port Arthur, Texas: \$50,000

Rebuild organization's public shelter, storage building and chapel that serve Jefferson County residents.

HURRICANE-DAMAGED HOUSING REHABILITATION

Habitat for Humanity of Jefferson County Home After Harvey: \$50,000

Repair and replace multiple Habitat homes damaged by Hurricane Harvey, part of a recovery effort that will affect around 68 homes.

United Way of Orange County Home Recovery Help for Orange County: \$50,000

Provide home repairs for Orange County residents; purchase drywall, insulation and other supplies needed to repair and construct damaged homes.

Family Services of Southeast Texas Family Services Women and Children's Shelter Flooring Replacement: \$65,781

Repair flooring damage to the Beaumont Women's and Children's Shelter caused by Hurricane Harvey.

Catholic Charities of Southeast Texas 2017 Harvey Floods Golden Pass Project: \$60,000

Support Port Arthur families impacted by Hurricane Harvey and facilitate home repairs.

Recovery Assistance for Port Arthur/Sabine Pass residents: \$50,000

Provide mattresses, furniture and appliances to Port Arthur and Sabine Pass residents impacted by Hurricane Harvey.





ROUND 2 (SPRING 2018) GRANT RECIPIENTS

SCHOOL MATERIALS REIMBURSEMENT

The Port Arthur Education Foundation Replacement technology for Lamar State College-Port Arthur: \$25,000

Rebuild technology section of LSC-PA building and provide electrical work and wiring, 30 replacement computers, and one projector.

Port Arthur Education Foundation Replacement uniforms for Port Arthur ISD students: \$15,000

Replace uniforms lost and destroyed during Hurricane Harvey for up to 650 Port Arthur elementary students.

Orangefield High School Rebuild Orangefield High School: \$5,000

Replace and rebuild property and materials for the arts department of Orangefield High School.

Little Cypress-Mauriceville ISD Mobile devices for career success: \$25,000

Replace and provide up to 48 laptops and associated storage equipment lost during the storm.

Jefferson County Emergency Service District #1 Gear and equipment replacement: \$5,000

Replace and provide wildland and bunker gear and necessary equipment lost in the storm.

HURRICANE-DAMAGED HOUSING REHABILITATION

SETX Civilian Task Force Adopt-a-Home: \$25,000

Replace appliances, furniture and other necessities for at least 20 families impacted by Hurricane Harvey.

Hurricane Relief to TAC Southeast District: \$50,000

Rebuild storm-damaged homes in the Port Arthur area with priority for elderly, disabled, low-income, and other disadvantaged or overlooked groups.

Repair several Port Arthur homes damaged by Hurricane Harvey.
